Credit unions are regulated by the Financial Services Authority and are not-for-profit organizations which operate as financial co-operatives and offer services such as **saving accounts and low-cost loans** to their members. They offer low-cost alternatives to loans from doorstep lenders and are cheaper and safer than borrowing from an illegal lender or loan shark.

Children can open accounts too!

Credit unions aim to help people take control of their money by encouraging them to save what they can. Once they have a reliable record as a saver, people can apply to borrow money from their credit union, which will let them borrow what they can afford to repay.

A great way to start saving towards events and birthdays.
