Year 6 Expectations

- Children need to be in school on time every morning at 8.45am because they have morning maths and reading work set for them.
- Please make sure that your child's name is on every item of their clothing and that they come into school in their PE kits on a Tuesday and Wednesday ©
- No jewellery is to be worn apart from studded earrings, which
 the child needs to be able to remove for PE.
- Full school uniform is expected everyday.

Online Safety

Have a conversation with your child about online safety.

- Explore online together
- Know who your child is communicating with online
- Set rules and agree boundaries
- Make sure that content is age appropriate
- · Use parental controls to filter, restrict, monitor or report content
- Check that you child knows how to use privacy settings and reporting tools
- Timings
- Must be handed in to school



Behaviour

- When children show behaviour that goes against any of the school rules, they are given 'steps'.
- Step 1-reminder
- Step 2-final reminder
- Step 3-Think sheet in own time.
- Step 4-Time out in partner classroom.
- Step 5-Time out else where in school.
- There are further steps which involve parental contact but we rarely have to get to that stage.

Year 6 Expectations Home alone

- In year 6 children are permitted to go home alone only if the parent or carer has signed the home alone slip. Otherwise, your child will need to be collected.
- Please make sure you discuss road safety rules and plan a safe route with them.
- If you are unable to collect your child after school, it's your responsibility to let the school know who will be coming to collect them.
- We cannot release your child to an adult if we have not been informed prior to their collection.

Clubs

 If your child signs up for a club and receive a place, please ensure they understand that they have made a commitment and need to attend all sessions.
