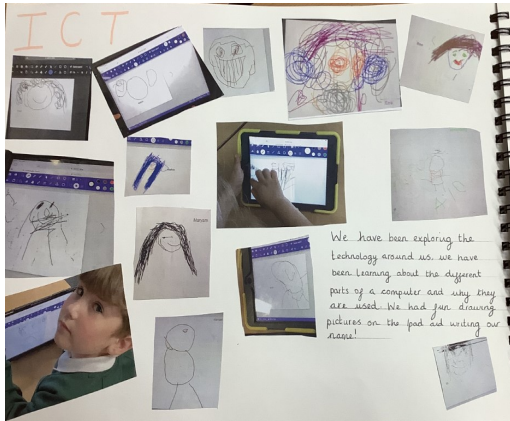




Computing

In **Year 1** children developed their digital media skills to create digital paintings.

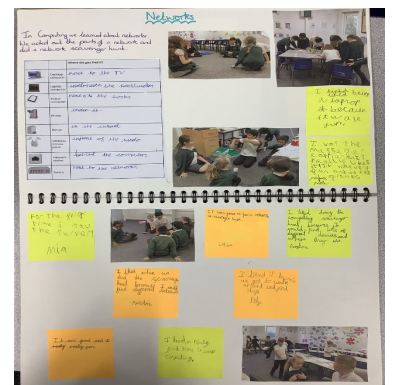


Dear families,
