What does the school day look like for your child?

School Hours

The gates will open at **8.45 am** and the children will come into the playground to line up with their teacher.

Lunch starts at 11.45 and afternoon sessions begin at 12.30 pm.

The school day ends at **3.15pm**.

Please note PE is on a Monday and Tuesday. Please send your child to school in their PE kit on those days.

Collecting Your Child

Please line up outside the Reception door and staff will hand your child to you. Children are asked not to come until a member of staff call their names. All children **must be** collected by a responsible adult who is known to the staff.

Reception Ready

Ready for Reception your child should be able to independently:

- ✓ Wash their hands
- ✓ Go to the toilet
- ✓ Put their own coat on and zip it up
- ✓ Put on their shoes and fasten their velcro
- ✓ Take turns and share with others
- ✓ Recognise their name, and ideally be able to write it

What will we be learning?

Within the Early Years curriculum there are 7 areas of development:

- Mathematics
- Understanding of the World
- Expressive Arts and Design

We try and make learning as exciting as possible giving children lots of time to explore our topics in the environment.

The First Day

Be Ready...

- Good bedtime
- Morning routine
- Healthy breakfast
- School uniform -all labelled!
- Velcro shoes named
- Calm start to the day

Bring...

- A smile
- Book bag labelled
- A water bottle labelled
- A bag of spare clothes

(if you feel your child will need them)

How can you help at home?

- Read to your child for 10 minutes everyday children will choose a book from school for you to share with them.
- Once children are confident in blending they will bring home a reading book.
 Please read this with them every night.
- Play games with your child, encourage them to take turns, talk in sentences and how to deal with losing sometimes.
- Ensure children do not spend more than 1 hour a day on a screen.
- Go for walks and talk about what you can see and hear around them.
- Lots of counting, finding more and less, number bonds, shapes etc.
- Sing nursery rhymes and other songs.
