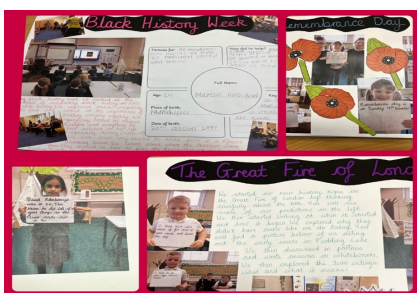


EYFS have been finding out about significant people as well as talking about past and present events in their own lives. They have also enjoyed finding out about traditional Fairy Tales.



In **Year 1**, children have been enjoying finding out about toys from the past. They have been using words and pictures to show their findings. They have even made their own cup and ball games.

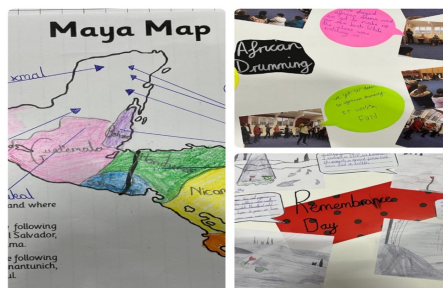
Year 2 have completed work about Planet Earth. As well as finding out about ways to save the planet, they have researched environmentalists like David Attenborough.
