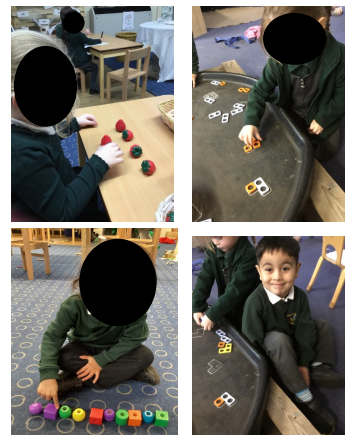
Times Tables Challenge!

Some of our year 4 pupils took part in the Trust Maths Challenge, focusing on times tables and working alongside other schools in the trust. It was exciting to see them collaborate, compete and show off their maths skills!



Nursery

In Nursery, the children have been exploring the number 3! They've been spotting groups of three and counting objects up to 3! It's wonderful to see them learning to recognise and enjoy numbers through play!



Reception

In Reception, the children have been developing their confidence when subitising and using their 1:1 correspondence skills. They've been quickly recognising small numbers without counting and matching objects one-to-one, building a strong foundation for their early maths learning!

Year 1

Year 1 have been exploring capacity this week! The children have been measuring and comparing different amounts, including looking at which object is heavier or lighter.

Year 2

Year 2 have been learning about multiplication and division! The children are practising times tables, sharing objects into groups, and discovering how numbers can be multiplied and divided in fun, hands-on ways.

KS2 Maths

In KS2, the children have been developing their problem-solving skills by tackling open-ended questions and discussing their ideas with peers. It's been fantastic to see them thinking critically, sharing different strategies, and learning from each other!



Times Table Rock Stars (TTRS)

TTRS what is it?

Times Tables Rock Stars is an online learning platform to support children with their recall and fluency of times tables.

Numbots

Numbots what is it?

NumBots is an online learning platform to support children with their recall and fluency in mental addition and subtraction, so that they move from counting to calculating.



How can you support your child?
