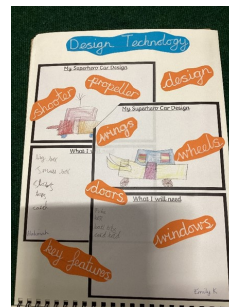

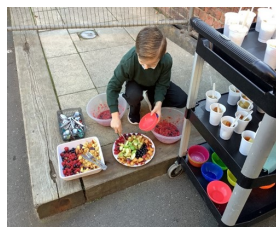
In the **Autumn Term**, the whole school made Christmas T Shirts.
