Bonjour!

At our school the children learn French as a Modern Foreign Language. The four strands of learning a modern foreign language are speaking, listening, reading and writing. Using questions is an effective way to engage children's listening. Learning how to answer them offers an opportunity to practice pronunciation as we start to develop short conversations. Here are some of the questions we are learning to listen for and answer.

Year 4

Tu as un animal?

The children asked each other this question in order to complete their survey about pet ownership. Learning the French vocabulary for animals names helped them to answer it.



We like to record our voices as we have conversations and answer questions. We save these recordings onto QR codes so that we can listen back to them later.




Year 3

Comment tu t'appelle?

Ça va?

After learning the vocabulary to greet someone the children start to extend their conversation skills by asking someone's name and how they are feeling. They enjoyed taking part in lots of role play in order to practice.



Year 6

Où vas-tu?

Learning to say different directions helps to answer- Where are you going?

Quel temps fait-il?

Using vocabulary about the weather we learn to give you a weather forecast!



Qu'est-ce que tu veux? C'est combien?

Using role play allows us to become shop keeper and customer, we can ask and answer these questions and practice using the food item vocabulary that we know.

Year 5

Tu est comment? elle est comment? Il est comment?

The children develop their descriptions as they learn more adjectives

After learning some basic time vocabulary the children are able to talk about different activities
