# Behaviour

- ▶ When children show behaviour that goes against any of the school rules, they are given 'steps'.
- ▶ Step 1 - reminder
- ▶ Step 2 - final reminder
- ▶ Step 3 - Think sheet in own time.
- ▶ Step 4 - Time out in partner classroom.
- ▶ Step 5 - Time out else where in school.
- ▶ There are further steps which involve parental contact but we rarely have to get to that stage.

# Medicines
