During the **Autumn Term** Reception have focused on good behaviour, the importance of rules and playing cooperatively and sharing.



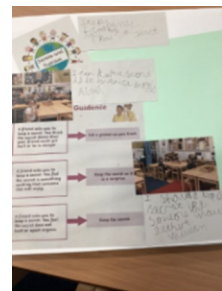
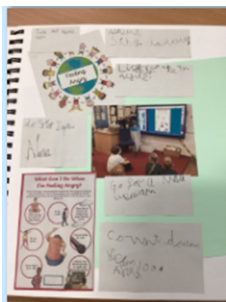
Dear families,

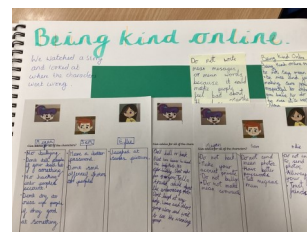
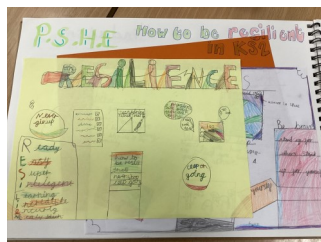
In the **Autumn Term**, the whole school revisited our three school rules:
